British Horseball Association Photography & Videography usage guidance



Photographing and Filming Children in Sport

Parents/carers often want to be able to celebrate the achievements of their children when taking part in sporting activities through taking photographs or films. Sports organisations may also want to promote their activities to encourage increased participation. The Child Protection in Sport Unit recommends that appropriate and proportionate safeguards should be in place to ensure a safe sporting environment for children and young people. The guidance applies whether images are taken using cameras, mobile phones or any other equipment.

In accordance with the Child Protection in Sport Unit (CPSU) child protection policy, we will not permit photographs, video or other images of young people to be taken without consent. If the child is under 16, consent must be obtained from a parent/carer.

You must dictate when joining the British Horseball Association as a member whether you give or do not give consent for the BHA to use photos of the member as described in this document, via the compulsory tick box on the BHA membership form.

Consent is voluntary and you may withdraw consent at any time by contacting the British Horseball Association at membership@britishhorseball.co.uk

The British Horseball Association will take all steps to ensure these images are used solely for the purposes for which they are intended. If you become aware that these images are being used inappropriately, please inform us immediately at compliance@britishhorseball.co.uk

Usage guidelines; photos and videos may be used for the following purposes:

- BHA and BHA registered clubs display purposes
- BHA and BHA registered clubs printed publications
- BHA and BHA registered clubs website
- BHA and BHA registered clubs social media pages
- BHA and BHA registered clubs training or analysis purposes

In line with the recommendation in the British Horseball Associations Photography & Videography Policy, at all BHArun events, it is requested that any person wishing to engage in any video, zoom or close range photography should register their details with BHA event organisers at events@britishhorseballco.uk at least 48 hours prior to the event starting, before carrying out any such photography.

If parents have any particular concern about their young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the BHA event organiser or safeguarding officer.
